Provide evidence of the broad comprehensive infusion of technology throughout the school district. The narrative is limited to 2000 words, two (2) pages in length, 10-12 point font, Arial or Times New Roman, and 1" margins.

## ***Part C: Technology in the Curriculum***

Provide evidence of the technology use throughout curricular areas. The narrative is limited to 2000 words, two (2) pages in length, 10-12 point font, Arial or Times New Roman, and 1" margins.

## ***Part D: Technology Use for Student Achievement***

Provide evidence of technology use to meet individual student needs. The narrative is limited to 2000 words, two (2) pages in length, 10-12 point font, Arial or Times New Roman, and 1" margins.

## ***Part E: Alignment to Current State Standards and Skills for Instructional Technology***

Provide evidence of how technology use aligns with current state standards and skills for instructional technology. The narrative is limited to 2000 words, two (2) pages in length, 10-12 point font, Arial or Times New Roman, and 1" margins.

## ***Part F: Still Images***

Include four (4) to six (6) still photographs related to the criteria of this application/nomination form. Photographs may be used in print media or on the OTA website. Ensure that images of students are allowed for publication based on your school district's policy.

## ***Part G: Letters of Support***

Three (3) letters of support may be included in the application/nomination. Letters may be from patrons, parents, local businesses, students, or others.
